**A RESOLUTION OF THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL
MODIFYING THE CITY COUNCIL AT-LARGE APPOINTEE
REQUIREMENTS TO THE ARTS COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the City Council established the Arts Committee by City Council Minute Action on April 29, 1974; and

WHEREAS, the charge of the Arts Committee is to advise the City Council on cultural and artistic matters within the City including the acquisition and placement of public art. The Committee adheres to the Public Arts Master Plan, the Art in Public Places Ordinance and the Public Arts Project Plan in order to support, develop and promote art in Albany and increase the economic vitality of the City; and

WHEREAS, the current composition of the Arts Committee includes seven members, one appointed by each Council Member, one City Council “as a whole” (previously known as Council At-Large) appointment, and one Board of Education appointment: and

WHEREAS, the City Council has expressed an interest in broadening the composition of the Arts Committee to include a representative from the business community with experience in public art, cultural and artistic matters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council hereby modifies the City Council “as a whole” appointment to the Arts Committee to allow for an appointee, whenever possible, that represents the local business community with experience in the fields of public art, cultural and artistic matters, and that said appointee need not be a resident of the City of Albany.
