

1 RESOLUTION NO. 82 - 24

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY ESTABLISHING THE
3 CITY OF ALBANY ARTS GUILD.

4 WHEREAS, the City of Albany has an active arts community; and

5 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany desires to coordinate
6 and promote the artists and the cultural activities within the City; and

7 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany is interested in
8 providing a mechanism for soliciting financial support for the artistic and
9 cultural activities within the City through grants and local voluntary
10 gifts; and

11 WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to involve a broad spectrum of artists
12 within the community;

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY

14 THAT, the Council hereby establishes the ALBANY ARTS GUILD. The
15 purpose of this non-profit, voluntary body will be to perform the following
16 functions:

17 1. To become a resource to be used within the local community to
18 enhance and promote artistic and cultural activities;

19 2. To provide a network of communications between local artists and
20 the community as a whole;

21 3. To coordinate interagency arts activities;

22 4. To advise the City Council regarding artistic and cultural activities
23 within the City;

24 5. To apply for grants to support and enhance the arts and other
25 cultural activities within the City;


26 6. To provide a needs assessment and inventory of cultural resources
27 and facilities within the City of Albany, including display and performing
28 arts areas;

1 7. To prepare an annual report of artistic and cultural activities
2 within the City. This report is due March 1 of each year.

3 FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the ARTS GUILD will consist of ten (10)
4 members: two (2) appointed by each of the Councilmembers. These members
5 need not be artists themselves, but should be interested in the promotion
6 of art and cultural activities. In addition to the ten (10) regular members,
7 there may be ten (10) alternates. Each regular member may appoint his/her
8 own alternate. The terms of the members and alternates will be for one (1)
9 year; but there will be no limit as to how often a person can be re-appointed
10 to the Arts Guild. Ex-officio members from other community organizations
11 shall be encouraged to participate as fully as possible. Arts will be
12 defined as broadly as possible in order to include a full range of artistic
13 expression.

14 FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Arts Guild shall be under the
15 jurisdiction of all State laws of duly appointed public advisory committees.

16 FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, since this organization is a non-profit,
17 voluntary organization, it, and it alone, will be responsible for its internal
18 fiscal matters. It shall develop procedures which must be approved by the
19 City Administrator and the Finance Director of the City of Albany. These
20 procedures will show how funds are accounted for and disbursed. The Arts
21 Guild will be in charge of maintaining detailed records of all expenditures
22 made of all funds received.
